Sealed bids will be received by the Walton County Board of Commissioners no later than **2:00 p.m., Tuesday, September 8, 2015**, for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and any other miscellaneous items necessary for the State Route 138 at Business 10 Widening Project for the Walton County Board of Commissioners. Bids shall be marked and labeled as **State Route 138 at Business 10 Widening Project**. Any bid received after said time and date of bid opening will not be considered by OWNER. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at this time and location. All bids will be evaluated by OWNER, and the project will be awarded, if it is awarded, within sixty (60) days of the bid opening.

The Project consists of, but is not limited to the following major elements:

Existing roadway widening, storm drainage, traffic markings, and miscellaneous appurtenances.

Time of completion for all work associated with this project shall be ONE HUNDRED TWENTY (120) consecutive calendar days from the date of a written "Notice to Proceed" from OWNER.

Copies of Contract Documents, Specifications, and Construction Drawings may be obtained from the Walton County Purchasing Department, Rhonda Hawk, Purchasing Manager, 111 South Broad Street, Historic Courthouse, Monroe, Georgia, 30655, upon payment of a non-refundable cost of \$150.00. Checks shall be made payable to Walton County Board of Commissioners.

OWNER requires a bid bond* or a certified cashier's check in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid to be enclosed with the bid at the time of bid opening. Cashier's check will be made payable to the Walton County Board of Commissioners. Bidders must submit with the bid a Contractor Affidavit verifying compliance with the Federal Work Authorization Program known as E-Verify. This form must be notarized.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish OWNER with Insurance, Workman's Compensation Insurance, and Performance and Payment Bonds* in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) of the total bid.

OWNER reserves the right to reject any bid based on evaluations and investigations of bidder's quality, workmanship, or adherence to schedule on previous projects. The contract shall be awarded based on the best interest of the OWNER, as determined by the OWNER.
